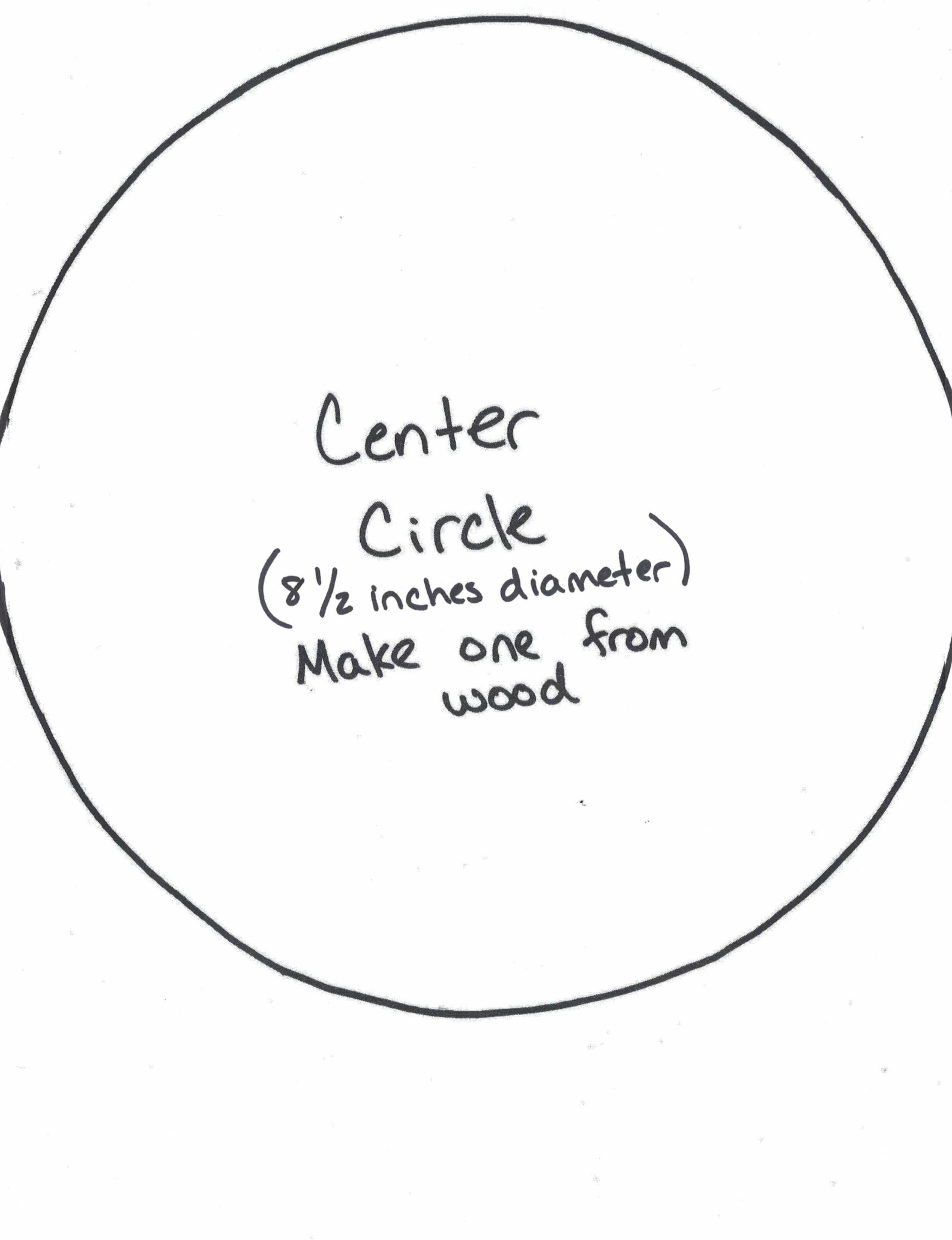

(8 1/2 inches diameter)

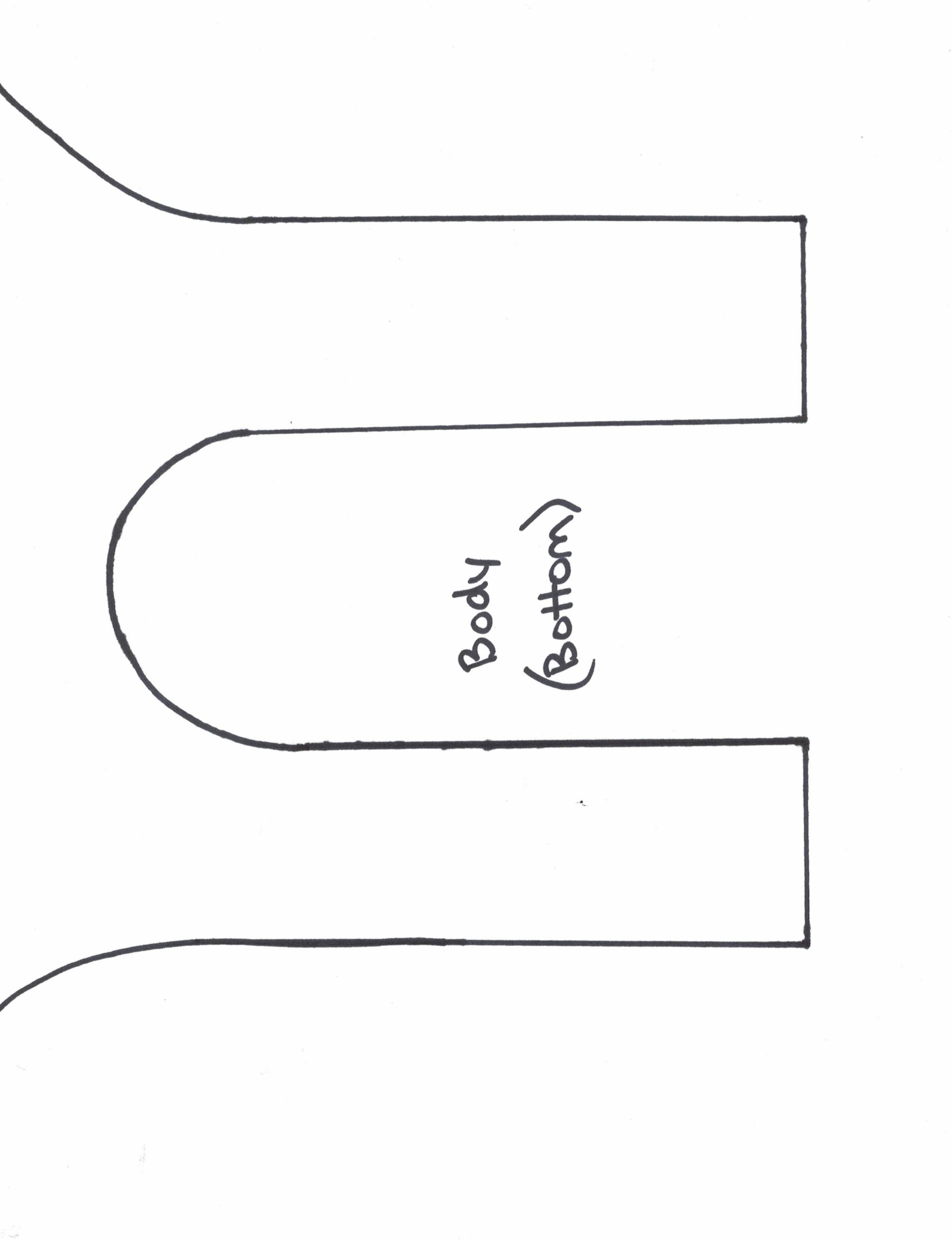
Make one from

taped together.

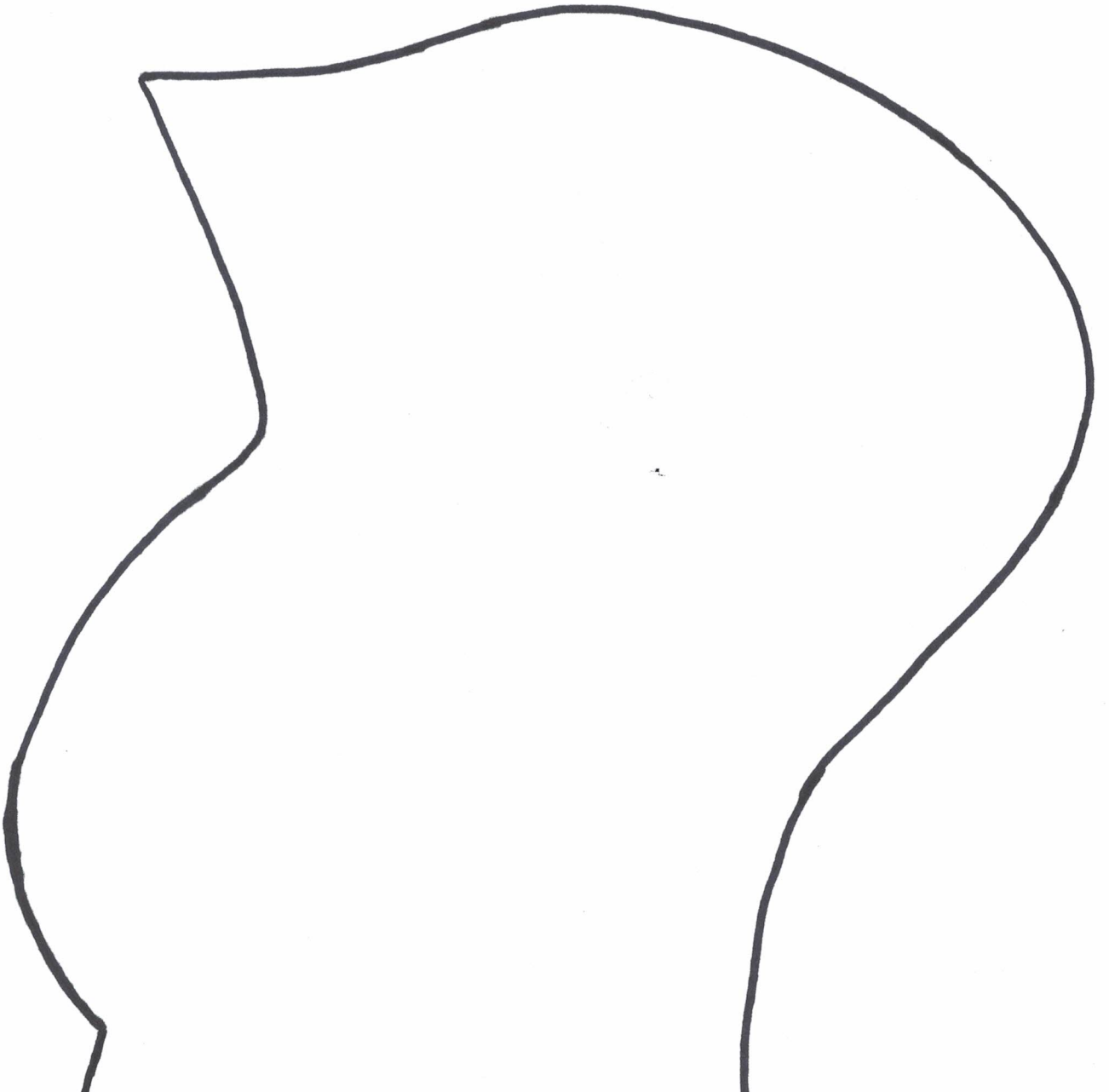


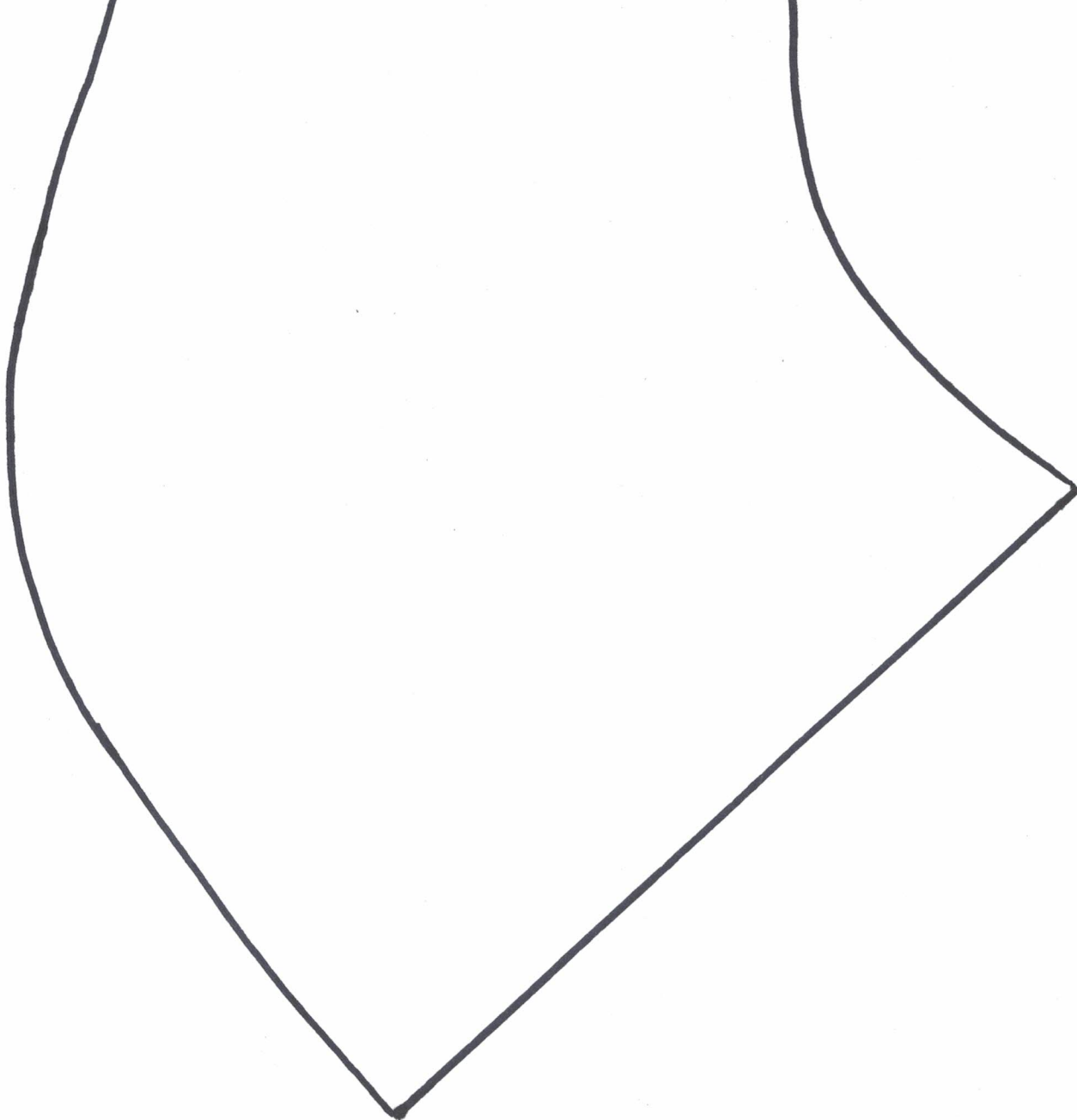

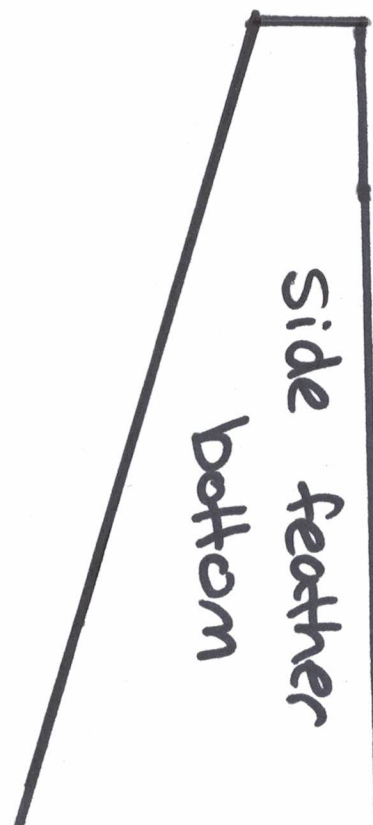

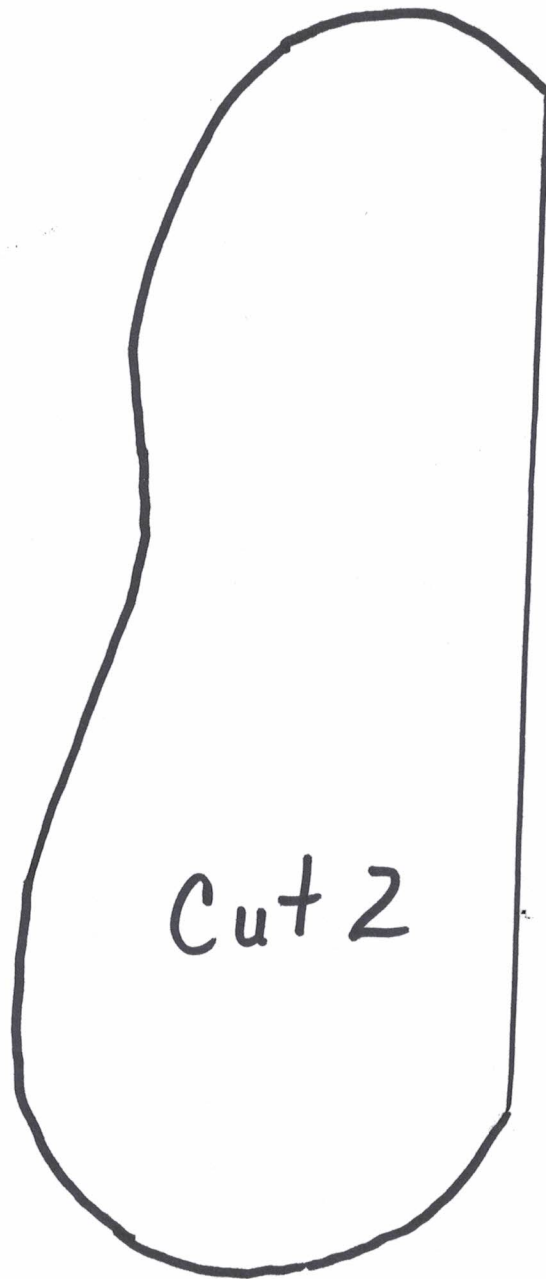
